SUBJECT: *IBCC/ROUNDTABLE ISSUES*

1. IBCC

The IBCC actually has a meeting scheduled for November 30th. I have not seen an agenda, but I expect that it will include an update on funding options and a review of what's happening in each basin. I will coordinate my resignation from the IBCC with Andy. The position I'm in is appointed by the governor. I would strongly recommend you urge Andy be appointed to this position.

2. Joint West Slope Roundtable Study

The study is progressing as intended and the results are quite interesting. We'll have John Carron show some of the results on Tuesday during his presentation. Remember, one of the goals of this study is to evaluate the state-mod (the state's Colorado River model) and make recommendations on improvements so we can use it in conjunction with the Bureau of Reclamation's CRSS to evaluate demand management options at the sub-basin scale. One of our final tasks will be to make presentations to the West Slope roundtables. One option that I believe we should consider is a joint West Slope roundtable meeting where we could discuss both the results of the risk study and the results of SWSI. The two studies are very much connected. Why? Because SWSI will include a detailed update of demands throughout the state.

I hope to stay involved through the completion of the risk study and recommendations for the next phase which will be both controversial and necessary.
